— Dear TP52 Members and Associate Members,

To be clear on how questions on rules will be dealt with, the following:

1. There shall be Questions and Requests for Interpretation.

2. Questions on any issue related to the TP52 Class can be brought forward to the Class Manager by any means (phone, email, on the dock, etc.) and can be on request treated as confidential. The answer will be given as soon as possible, but not later than 3 weeks. The answer is not an official TP52 Class Interpretation and cannot be referred to as such at a later date.

3. Requests for Interpretation are only possible in relation to the TP52 Class Rule (and applicable rules), Bylaws and Interpretations. Such a Request has to be submitted in writing/email and will be answered in writing/email within 3 weeks. The Interpretation, including the Request, will be published on the TP52 Class website within 6 weeks of giving the answer. A request for confidentiality will be denied. The Class Manager has the obligation to discuss the matter with a Class Measurer in case of a Rule/Interpretation related matter, or with the Chairman of the ExCom in case of a Bylaws issue.

The Class Manager has the choice to involve outside experts for formulating the Interpretations. If that causes the need for more time, he will inform the person that put in the Request of the delay and give him a proper indication of the time needed.
